It is the same with good wine. Each sip holds traces of the earth that supported

the vines, the work of the winemaker's hand, and the place from which the fruit came.

The grapes for the Syrah came from a single vineyard, Edna Ranch,

set amid the rolling hills of the Edna Valley in San Luis Obispo County, California.

The resulting wine offers flavors of raspberry, ripe plum, cherry, herbs, and

hints of black pepper paralleled by color of equal depth. Lush and elegant, the flavors are met with well-integrated oak, enticing tannins, and a finish

of smoked spice and lightly lingering berry...Enjoy!

Winemaker's Notes:

The grapes for this Syrah came from a single vineyard, Edna Ranch, which is tucked away among the rolling hills of the Edna Valley in San Luis Obispo County, California. The resulting wine offers deep, rich aromas of raspberry, ripe plum, cherry, herbs, and hints of black pepper paralleled by color of equal depth. Lush and elegant, the flavors mirror these aromatics with well-integrated oak and are framed by enticing tannins. Lastly, a finish of smoked spice and berry lingers just long enough until the next sip...Enjoy!

Tin House Winery is a small, family-owned and operated winery, concentrating on three varietals: Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Syrah. Because we only produce limited vintages, our wines exhibit intimate craftsmanship and have a distinct, artisan character.

Winemaking is in our blood. In Hungary, generations of ancestors tended family estates in the centuries-old Carpathian growing region. From the fertile soil they brought untold vintages, crafted in the old world tradition. We imagine them, with sleeves rolled up, patient and earnest, hard at work in one of the rustic tin sheds where the wine was produced. It is this image that guides us today, and helped inspire our trademark, the tin house.

Today, Tin House Winery combines the best old world winemaking traditions with the incredible opportunities for creativity offered by California's prolific Central Coast growing region. While actually produced in Santa Maria, our wines feature grapes from Santa Barbara County and the Edna Valley, located in San Luis Obispo.
